World University of Science and Technology, hereafter referred to as **WUST**, being a legal entity and acting according to the legislation of Georgia, is legally represented under the charter by the **President Dr. Farzad Ghasemzadeh** (hereafter – First Party),

and

Altamimi International University, hereafter referred to as **ALTAMIMI**, being a legal entity and acting according to the legislation of Kyrgyzstan, is legally represented under the charter by the **Rector Dr. Edilbek Asymbekov** (hereafter –Second Party).

Both of parties hereinafter separately referred to as the "Party", collectively – the "Parties", have decided to enter into the present memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") and agree with conditions as follows.

Article1. Purpose

The Parties believe that the quality of research and teaching is enhanced with the establishment of international cooperation, and wish to enter into collaboration with a goal of mutual enrichment in scientific, academic and cultural areas.

Article2. Areas of Cooperation

The parties agree to cooperate in the following areas:

- 2.1. **Establishment of the WUST International Cooperation Office at Altamimi University:**
This office will be responsible for developing scientific, educational, and research collaborations with partner universities on a global scale.
- 2.2. **Attracting International Students:**
Planning to attract students from various countries through development programs proposed by WUST will be a priority of this collaboration.
- 2.3. **Conducting Joint Programs:**
Organizing joint programs and awarding dual degrees to students to enhance educational quality and attract international students.
- 2.4. **Organizing Scientific Conferences:**
Conferences will be held to facilitate the exchange of knowledge and experiences, in collaboration with other universities and under the management of the International Cooperation Office.
- 2.5. **Conducting Short-term Courses and Specialized Workshops:**
Short-term courses and specialized workshops in the field of medical sciences will be organized in collaboration with other universities and supervised by the International Cooperation Office.
- 2.6. **Exchange of Faculty and Students:**
Facilitating the exchange of faculty and students with partner universities as an effective strategy to improve educational and research quality.
- 2.7. **Production and Publication of Scientific Articles and Journals:**
The production of scientific journals and the publication of joint articles in collaboration with partner universities will be conducted to enhance the scientific standing of the institutions and disseminate research findings.

Article3. Obligations of the Parties

- 3.1. The Parties intent to assist each other in achieving the objectives outlined in this MOU.
- 3.2. Each item outlined in Article 2 will be implemented through separate agreements.
- 3.3. Detailed areas of cooperation, as well as exact conditions of cooperation in each area will be described in separate agreement.

Article4. Financial Terms of the MOU

Based on the type of cooperation in Article 2 of the MOU, separate agreements will be signed and financial condition will be mentioned separately there. **Parties have no financial commitment to this MOU.**

Article5. MOU Administrators

Ultimate responsibility for this MOU lies with the rector/president of each institution, but administrative responsibility for its administration will be delegated to the following officers at each institution.

- 5.1. On behalf of First Party: Dr. Ardalan Mazloomi, Vice Rector for International Relations.
- 5.2. On behalf of Second Party: Dr. Hafiz Muhammad Arsalan, Professor and Head of Department of Clinical Biochemistry.

Article6. Validity of the MOU

- 6.1. This MOU starts from February, 2025 and will be valid for 10 years which it comes to force by signing authorized representatives of both Parties.
- 6.2. Either Party may terminate MOU by giving the other Party a six-month prior written notice.
- 6.3. The MOU may be terminated upon written consent of the Parties as well.
- 6.4. When the MOU is terminated, parties are obliged to fulfill their obligations towards all students and clients in the programs that already registered or signed contract before the ending of this MOU.
- 6.5. The terms of the MOU can be amended only upon mutual consent of the Parties, addendums and amendments are valid only if they are made in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of the Parties.

Article7. Signatures of the Parties

The MOU is drawn and signed in seven articles, two pages and two equally copies in English, which all of them are equally authentic and shall come into force upon the signature at both parties.
